About Corning NY:

Corning, NY is known as America's Crystal City, and has been at the forefront of the glass industry, from innovative technology and science (from light bulbs to Christmas ornaments to more modern wonders like fiber optics, Gorilla Glass and Valor Glass) to the remarkable artistic creations found at one of the many artisan glass shops/studies around the city. Corning's Historic Market Street was named "one of the Top 10 Great Streets of the Year" by the American Planning Association, and Travel & Leisure named Centerway Square one of "America's Most Beautiful Town Squares."

Travel Information:

Flying: The recently renovated Elmira-Corning Regional Airport has two regional carriers: Allegiant and Delta. Allegiant has connections to several FL airports and Delta has connections through their hub in Detroit. If you choose to fly, there is a free shuttle to the Radisson Hotel in Corning (10 miles away) where there is a reserved block of rooms for the conference (see Lodging, below). There are also rental car agencies at the airport, including: Avis, Budget, Enterprise, Hertz and National for your convenience.

Driving: Corning is located just off both I-99 (formerly US 15) and I-86, so driving is certainly a good option. The address for the Radisson Hotel is: 125 Denison Parkway E, Corning, NY 14830. Directions to SUNY Corning College from the Radisson: from the parking lot on Denison Parkway, turn right at the end of the parking lot and then another immediate right onto Chemung Street. Cross Denison Parkway and follow Chemung Street to Upper Delevan Ave, where the street curves to the left and becomes Spencer Hill Road. Follow Spencer Hill Road for 3 miles; stay straight and the entrance to the college will be on your right. Detailed information about parking and conference locations will be sent later.

Lodging Information:

The conference hotel is the Radisson Hotel, Corning. The Radisson is located at the east end of Corning's beautiful Market Street and has a variety of amenities, including a free shuttle to/from the airport and to the conference destination at SUNY Corning Community College. Room rates will be: 1) 1 King Bed: \$120.00 per night or 2) 2 Queen Beds: \$130.00 per night. The exciting news is that the Radisson has graciously offered this reduced rate through the weekend following the conference. We hope you will make plans to extend your stay and

enjoy the beautiful Finger Lakes of NY, home of several world class beverage trails (wine, craft beers and ciders and distilleries).
